Tie Breaks: (see 2010 FEI World Cup™ Rules – Eventing) Should two or more riders have equal points in the final ranking; the following tie breaker system will be applied to determine the priority of riders' in the final Classification:

1. rider with highest placing in qualifiers;
2. in case of equal placing in qualifiers, lower total of penalties points, based on the lower sum of the totals of penalties points from both relevant competitions.

Intermediate standings with the Tie-breaks will be published after Haras du Pin FRA and the Final standings after Schenefeld GER.
