## ROLEX

### PRESENTATION OF ROLEX

Rolex is recognized the world over as the leader in the Swiss watchmaking industry and enjoys an unparalleled reputation for quality and know-how.

#### The birth of Rolex

The origins of Rolex date back to the beginning of the 20th century. At a time when pocket watches were still the order of the day, Hans Wilsdorf, a young Bavarian just 24 years old, wagered on the future of the wristwatch. The pioneering spirit of the founder is the subject of some of the finest chapters in the history of contemporary watchmaking and was the source of two major innovations. In 1926, Rolex invented the Oyster, the first waterproof and dustproof watch, and, in 1931, the first self-winding mechanism equipped with a Perpetual rotor. Over the years, Rolex created a full line of Oyster watches, with a strong identity and intrinsic features. Recognizable at a glance, this collection includes over 170 models available in a wide number of possible combinations. The Cellini collection later enhanced the choice offered to consumers loyal to legendary Rolex quality. The reliability and performance of the product have built the worldwide reputation of Rolex.

#### An international company

Today, Rolex is present in some one hundred countries. The company ensures the distribution of its watches and the quality of their maintenance through a network of 26 affiliates and several thousand official Rolex jewellers.

A Rolex watch is made to last. Assembled by hand, it benefits from the company's know-how and decades of cumulative expertise. An after-sales service, unique in its genre, ensures the proper functioning of the watches over time. It is based on the competence of nearly 4,000 watchmakers, trained by Rolex, who work for the affiliates or for jewellers of the Group worldwide. A universal and timeless brand, Rolex continues to conquer new markets and expand its presence worldwide.

#### State-of-the-art technology

Responding to growing demand while integrating the latest technologies requires constant evolution of the means of production. In the mid-1990s, Rolex opted for a vertical integration of its production facilities, thus ensuring its control over the manufacture of all its watch components and guaranteeing its autonomy. In the interest of consistency and efficiency, the company consolidated all its activities in Switzerland at four functional sites.

#### In Geneva

The Rolex headquarters is home to all the administrative activities of the company, to those related to the final assembly and sales of the watches, as well as to after-sales service.

The Chêne-Bourg site brings together all the activities related to the development and manufacture of the dial and gem-set elements.

The Plan-les-Ouates site groups all the activities related to the development, manufacture and quality control of the case and bracelet.

#### In Bienne

The Bienne site is the location of all the activities related to the manufacture and assembly of Rolex watch movements.

#### An image of excellence

The name Rolex is synonymous with performance. In 1927, Mercedes Gleitze, a young Englishwoman, swam the English Channel in over 10 hours wearing an Oyster. Upon arrival, the watch was still in perfect working order. The company immediately placed an advertisement in the *Daily Mail* proclaiming the success of the waterproof watch and chronicling "the debut of the Rolex Oyster and its triumphant march worldwide". This event also marked the start of a long association between Rolex and exceptional personalities who bear witness to the excellence of the product and are Testimonees of the brand. These associations give rise to numerous partnerships and sponsoring activities in fields as varied as art and culture, tennis, golf, sailing, and equestrian and automobile sports.

#### Perpetuating the spirit of enterprise

While committed to the principles that are the foundation of the brand, Rolex ventures to break with tradition to respond to changes in an ever-evolving world. The Group has reinforced its position as a leader in the watchmaking industry by conquering new markets and enhancing the image of the brand.

## ROLEX AND SPORTS

### A pioneering spirit in the name of excellence

Precise, waterproof and robust, at its launch in 1926 the Oyster was already synonymous with a pioneering spirit. Adapted to the lifestyle of a rapidly evolving society in which leisure played a more and more prominent role, this wristwatch was destined to gradually replace the traditional pocket watch.

The sports world offered an extraordinary field of validation and expansion for this timepiece of unprecedented quality. **Hans Wilsdorf**, founder of Rolex, achieved a master stroke in 1927 by equipping **Mercedes Gleitze**, a young Englishwoman, with a Rolex Oyster when she swam the English Channel. He reserved the front page of the **Daily Mail** to announce the event to the public at large. Even though the watch had remained immersed in the seawater for over 10 hours, it continued to keep accurate time, proof of its undeniable waterproofness and robustness. The young entrepreneur had just created the "Testimonee" campaign.

From then on, the advances of the Oyster would be inextricably linked to sportsmen and women excelling in disciplines that were new at the time, for example aviation, automobile racing or mountaineering: in 1933 **Stewart Blacker** flew over Everest; in 1947, pilot **Chuck Yeager** became the first person to break the sound barrier; in 1935, **Sir Malcolm Campbell** broke the land speed record in his bolide *Bluebird*, attaining 301 mph (484 km/h). In 1953, the expedition led by **Sir John Hunt**, **Sir Edmund Hillary** and **Tensing Norgay** was the first to conquer Everest. Through their achievements, these highly visible personalities underscore the technical qualities of the Oyster.

Over the years, new sports disciplines would be added. Today, Rolex is involved in five major sports: golf, sailing, tennis, equestrian sports and automobile sports. All of these disciplines combine precision and endurance, and call on participants to push themselves ever beyond their limits.

## ROLEX AND THE EQUESTRIAN SPORTS

Rolex has been present in equestrian sports **since 1957**. In these sports, excellence flows from flawless timing, precision and the grace of the horses and riders.

Today, Rolex is actively involved in **four disciplines**:

- **jumping**
- **eventing**
- **dressage**
- **polo**

Rolex is a partner of the **Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI)**, the major international association governing the sport, and also supports some thirty of the most renowned events on the international circuit.

Since 2002, Rolex has sponsored the **FEI World Equestrian Games**, considered to be the most prestigious equestrian competition in the world. This event, unique in its genre, takes place every four years at a different venue and brings together for two weeks the seven disciplines officially recognized by the international equestrian authorities: jumping, dressage, eventing, endurance, vaulting, driving and reining. In 2010, for the first time, an eighth discipline, para-equestrian sport, will be part of the programme.

Rolex is sponsoring the 2009 edition of the FEI European Jumping & Dressage Championships, a competition that takes place every two years.

In jumping particularly, Rolex is associated with several annual international competitions and events:

- the **CHIO Aachen** (Germany),
- the **CSI-W Geneva** (Switzerland),
- the **CSIO Spruce Meadows** (Canada),
- the **Brussels International Jumping** (Belgium),
- the **Rolex IJRC Top 10 Final**.

Since 2007, Rolex has been Title Sponsor of the **Rolex FEI World Cup™ Final**, one of the most exhilarating equestrian jumping competitions. Since the same date, Rolex has also been the Title Sponsor of the Western European League of the World Cup, which includes 13 competitions from October to March.

Rolex is also the "Official Timekeeper" of the Global Champions Tour, a series of high-level international outdoor jumping competitions.

## SERIES EDITORIAL

### ROLEX FEI WORLD CUP™ JUMPING - THE SWISS CONNECTION...

The 2009/2010 Rolex FEI World Cup™ Jumping series has a distinctly Swiss flavour to it. Devised by Swiss journalist Max Amman, run under the rules of the Lausanne-based Fédération Equestre Internationale and sponsored by the world's leading watchmaking company, Rolex, which is headquartered in Geneva where this season's final will take place, the popular series is celebrating its 32<sup>nd</sup> season.

Like most great ideas it has stood the test of time and become something of an institution. The sport of indoor show jumping has always had appeal, but the plan to create a super-tournament that would encourage riders from all around the world to fight for a qualifying spot at a grand final proved inspirational right from the start.

#### Developed and expanded

When the first season came to a close at the Scandinavium Arena in Gothenburg, Sweden in 1979 a total of 27 riders from nine countries competed for the title, but as this most popular of sports has developed and expanded over the intervening years the original two leagues have now grown to 14 and now reach the four corners of the earth. There are 13 events in both the Arab and North American West leagues, 15 in the North American East league, eight in South Central Europe, Japan and New Zealand, 11 in the Australia, four in the south East Asian League, seven in South America, five in South Africa, three in both the Central Asian and Caucasian Leagues and nine in the North Central European League.

However it is the Western European League that has provided the majority of the champions, including the present incumbent, Germany's Meredith Michaels-Beerbaum. Once again this season the Western European circuit begins in Oslo in Norway and takes in 13 qualifying events before the final which will be staged at the Palexpo Arena in Geneva from 14-18 April 2010.

#### Secret of success

The secret of the success of the Rolex FEI World Cup™ Jumping series lies in its simplicity. World-class course design, the very best horses and riders, the most prestigious indoor venues and guaranteed entertainment for both the discerning equestrian audience and the wider public alike. You don't have to be an aficionado of the sport of show jumping to recognise the skill, courage, tenacity and flair of the equine stars and their human counterparts as they tackle a tough course of fences in the enclosed environs of an indoor stadium. Spectators all around the globe will once again be enthralled by the communication between human and horse as they strive to leave all those fences standing and gallop home in the fastest time to secure that all-important win.

In the discipline of eventing, Rolex in the 1980s became the Title Sponsor of the **Rolex Kentucky Three-Day Event** (four-star event), which takes place annually in Lexington, Kentucky (United States). Rolex also sponsors two other major international competitions in this discipline: the **Mitsubishi Motors Badminton Horse Trials** (since 1999) and the **Land Rover Burghley Horse Trials** (since 2000). These two four-star contests take place in the United Kingdom.

In 2001, Rolex created the **Rolex Grand Slam of Eventing**. This trophy is awarded to the rider who wins consecutively at Lexington, Badminton and Burghley. To date, only British horsewoman Pippa Funnell has succeeded in this accomplishment, in 2003.

In polo, Rolex sponsors several prestigious events in Argentina, one of the leading countries in this discipline:

- the **Argentine Polo Open Championship**,
- the **Hurlingham Club Open Championship**,
- the **Tortugas Country Club Open Championship**,
- the **Buenos Aires Jockey Club Open Championship**.

In 2009, Rolex also sponsored the **Argentine Open Rematch** in which the two finalists of the South American match played each other in Deauville (France).

Rolex Testimonees include four men and women with exceptional records:

- Brazilian rider **Rodrigo Pessoa**, Olympic jumping champion, is considered to be one of the most remarkable riders of his generation;
- A German rider of American origin, **Meredith Michaels-Beerbaum** is the first woman to be ranked world number one in jumping (in 2005). In 2006, for the second time, she took first place on the podium at the Rolex IJRC Top 10 Final in Geneva. Meredith Michaels-Beerbaum won the Rolex FEI World Cup™ Final in 2005, 2008 and 2009;
- British rider **Zara Phillips**, a talented young horsewoman in the discipline of eventing, was awarded the title of individual world champion in 2006 at the FEI World Equestrian Games in Aachen;
- British rider **Pippa Funnell** is the first woman to be ranked number one in her speciality, eventing, and, to date, is the first rider ever to have won, in 2003, the Rolex Grand Slam of Eventing.

In the early years of the series riders from North America featured prominently, with US riders taking the title on six occasions and Canadians registering three victories. In recent times however Germans have dominated, and this season Germany's Meredith Michaels-Beerbaum could be in line for a new record. The diminutive Californian-born title-holder is going for her third consecutive win and, having previously come out on top in 2005, she will be the most successful competitor in the history of the series if she succeeds, because no-one else has ever taken this trophy four times.

### Hat-trick

Brazil's Rodrigo Pessoa scored a hat-trick between 1998 and 2000 riding Baloubet du Rouet and Austria's Hugo Simon, who was the first man ever to hold the coveted trophy aloft in 1979, won twice more in 1996 and 1997. Double-victories have been recorded by legendary partnerships like Canada's Ian Millar and Big Ben and Britain's John Whitaker and Milton but if Meredith, one of only four women to claim this ultimate prize, can do it again then she will establish a whole new standard.

It is her unique partnership with one of the greatest jumping horses of all time, the gelding Shutterfly, that has made her a formidable force. It seems that no fence is too high or too wide for this exceptional equine athlete who was in his sixteenth year when scooping the 2008/2009 title and that, together, they can raise the bar even higher for the rest of the best this season.

The Rolex brand is synonymous with lasting, quality performance, as are the partnership between Meredith and Shutterfly and the Rolex FEI World Cup™ Jumping series. It seems infinitely appropriate therefore that, after the 121 qualifying legs around the globe, the 2009/2010 champion will be crowned in the Swiss city which is home to the masters of timing.
